New This Week

- This week Building Permit data was included. There is not enough data to conclude any trends, but we will continue to watch the numbers the next few weeks to find trends (if any) between past years and COVID-19.
- Social Media Polls were conducted asking residents in Idaho Falls, Rigby, and Rexburg about how productive they are in working from home.
- About 61% of residents' children spend on average 2-3 hours per day on schoolwork.
- Madison County's traffic counts have increased again and are now above pre COVID-19 pandemic levels.
- Fuel prices have continued to drop across all Idaho Metropolitan areas.

Weekly Initial Unemployment Claims

Definitions

An **initial claim** is a claim filed by an unemployed individual after a separation from an employer. The claimant requests a determination of basic eligibility for the UI program. When an initial claim is filed with a state, certain programmatic activities take place and these result in activity counts including the count of initial claims. The count of initial claims for unemployment insurance is a leading economic indicator because it is an indication of emerging labor market conditions in the country. However, these are weekly administrative data which are difficult to seasonally adjust, making the series subject to some volatility.





Madison County Initial Claims by Week


Madison County Initial Claims by Occupation










Bonneville County Initial Claims by Occupation





Jefferson County Initial Claims by Week




Jefferson County Initial Claims by Occupation


Jefferson County Initial Claims by Industry








Madison County Building Permits 2020






Building Permits – Bonneville County





Bonneville County Building Permits 2020




Building Permits – Jefferson County

Jefferson County Building Permits 2020






Social Media Polls

On Average Many Hours per day Are Your Children Working on School Work?



Social Media Poll Hours Spent on School Work per Day


Average Number of Hours Spent on School Work per day in Eastern Idaho




Traffic Volumes - Bonneville






Traffic Volumes - Jefferson









Regular Gas Prices in East Idaho Counties


















US Hotel Weekly Data



US Hotel Weekly Occupancy Data



National Trends - Credit Unions




Key Points

- "The COVID-19 pandemic is expected to decrease credit unions' loan growth rate to only 2% in 2020, down from 6.5% last year, due to dismal new auto sales and weak home sales."
- COVID-19 is expected to decrease new vehicle sales by 50% in the second quarter.
- Due to the lack of car sales, credit unions new auto loans are expected to fall more than 20% this year and aren't expected to return to their normal volume until summer of 2022.
