


New This Week

- Building permit counts in Bonneville County and Jefferson Counties rose slightly this week
 while counts in Madison and Blaine Counties dropped slightly this week
- Hotel occupancy, rates, and revenue per room are continuing to rise each week
- 14 Restaurants were interviewed and most restaurants reopened in May after the Stay at Home Order
- 70% of restaurants interviewed are limiting food items because they cannot receive certain items from suppliers
- Traffic counts in all counties are continuing to rise since before the Stay at Home Order






Building Permits – Madison County






Building Permits – Bonneville County






Building Permits – Jefferson County






Building Permits – Bonneville, Jefferson, & Madison Counties

2020 Total Permit by Type






Building Permits – Blaine County





US Hotel Weekly Occupancy Data












When did you reopen your restaurant?







Upon reopening, what has your influx of customers been?


Reopened Capacity of Dining Area's in Restaurants






Some Restaurants had to limit food items because they could not receive certain items from suppliers.





- All restaurants that were interviewed do not require their customers to wear face masks




Do you feel you will be able to recover the loss of income due to the COVID-19 shut down? 14 responses





What percentage of your staff is still working since reopening? (14 responses)






Distribution of Grants by County








Grants Distributed Over Time






Distribution of Grants per Industry





Average Daily Traffic Volumes for 2020






Average Daily Traffic Volumes for 2020








Comparing Traffic: Ada County




















Average Daily Traffic Volumes for 2020




Idaho Metro Gasoline Prices






Idaho Falls Gasoline Prices

Idaho Falls' average regular gasoline prices with previous year comparison.






State Gasoline Price Comparison


