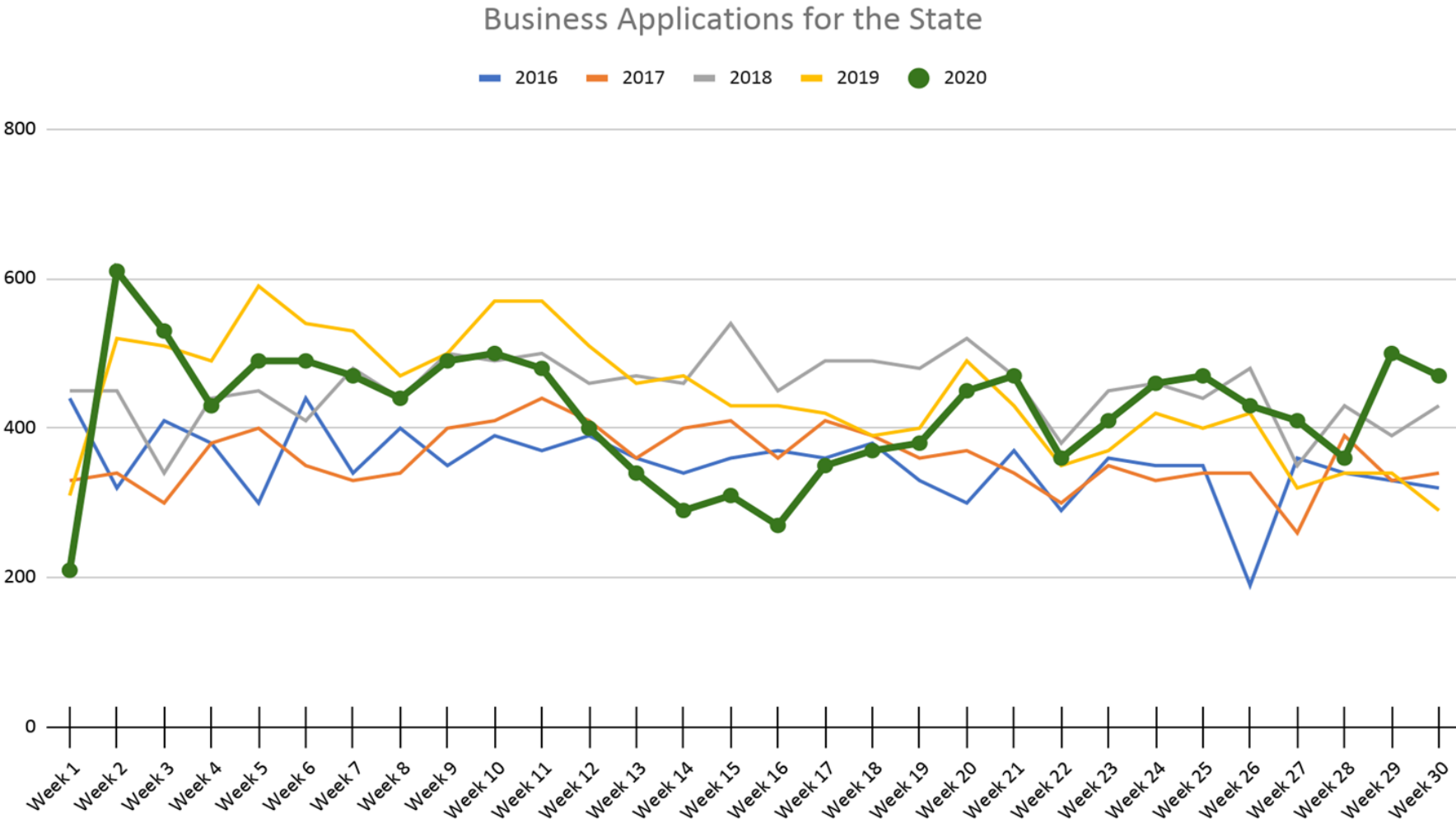

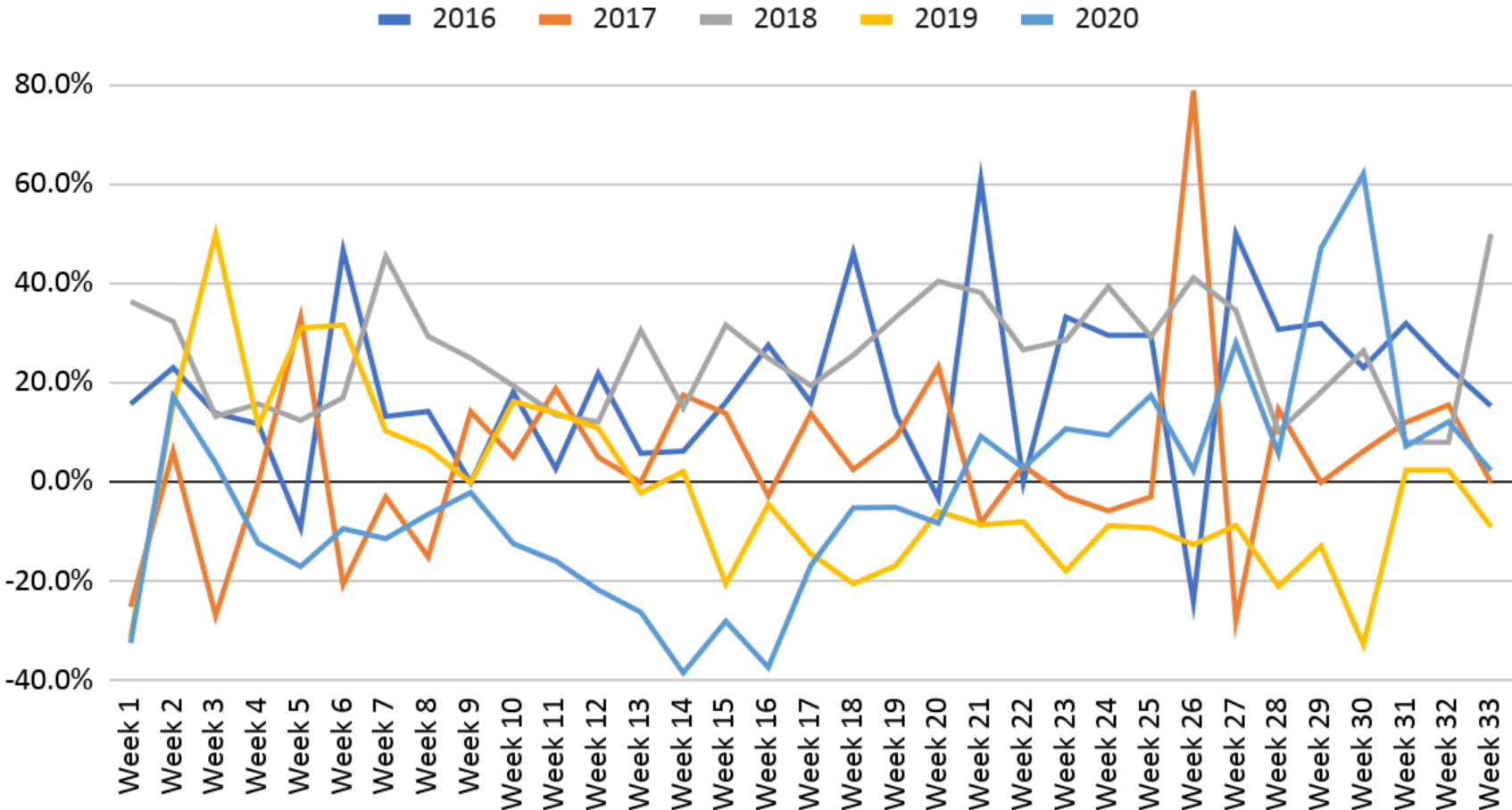

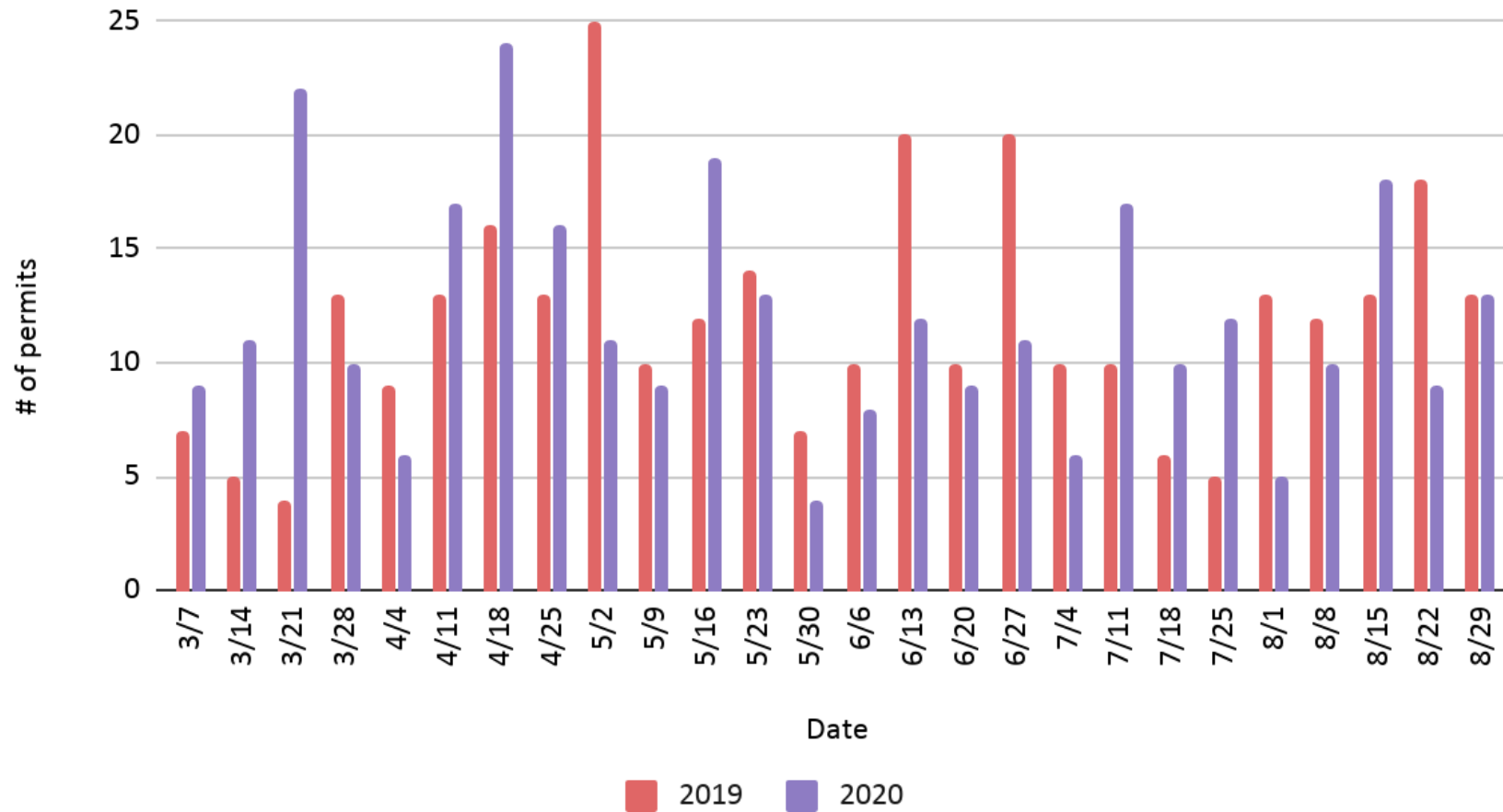
Business Formation Statistics (BFS Applications)

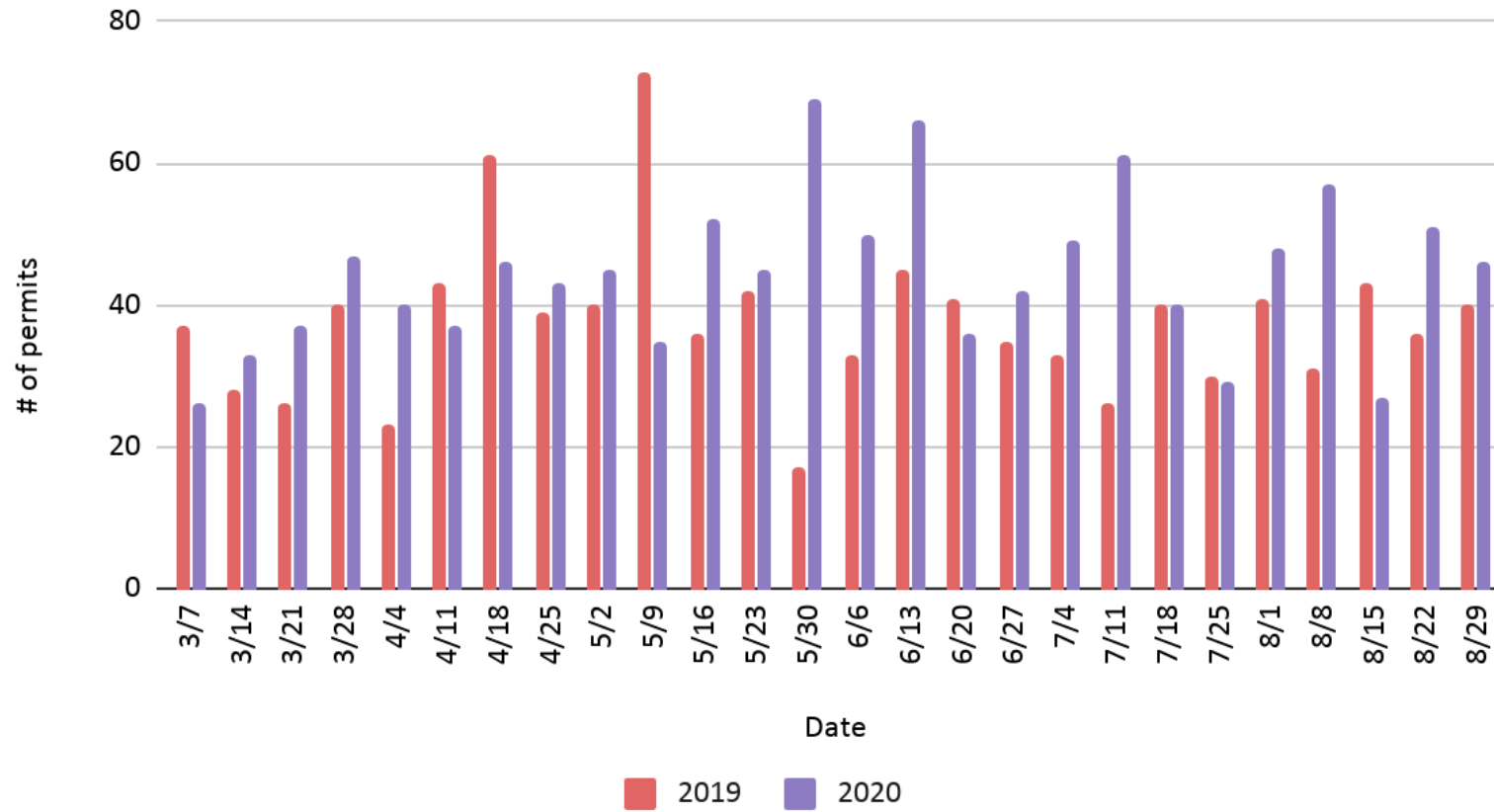
Madison Building Permits

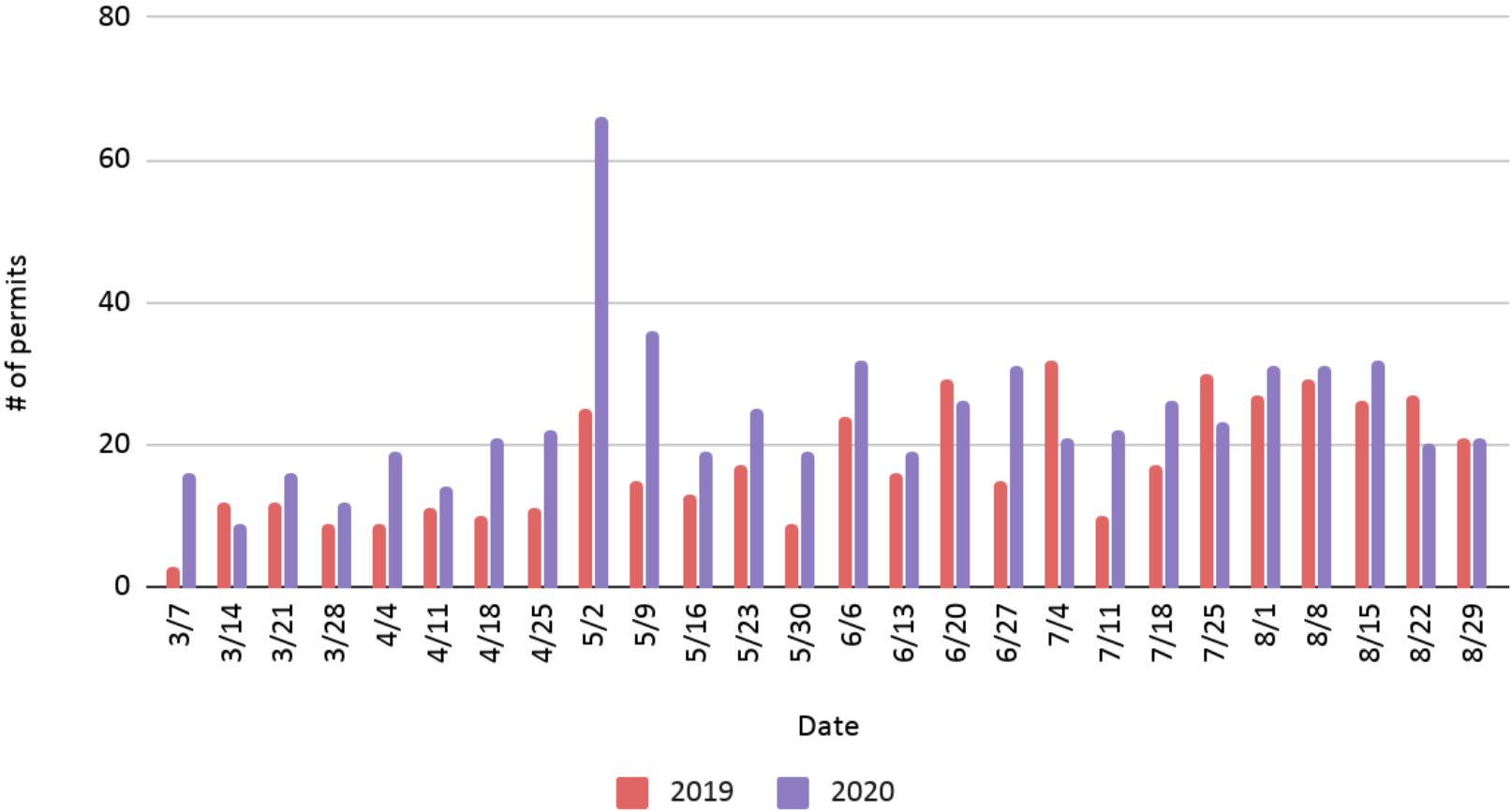
Bonneville Building Permits

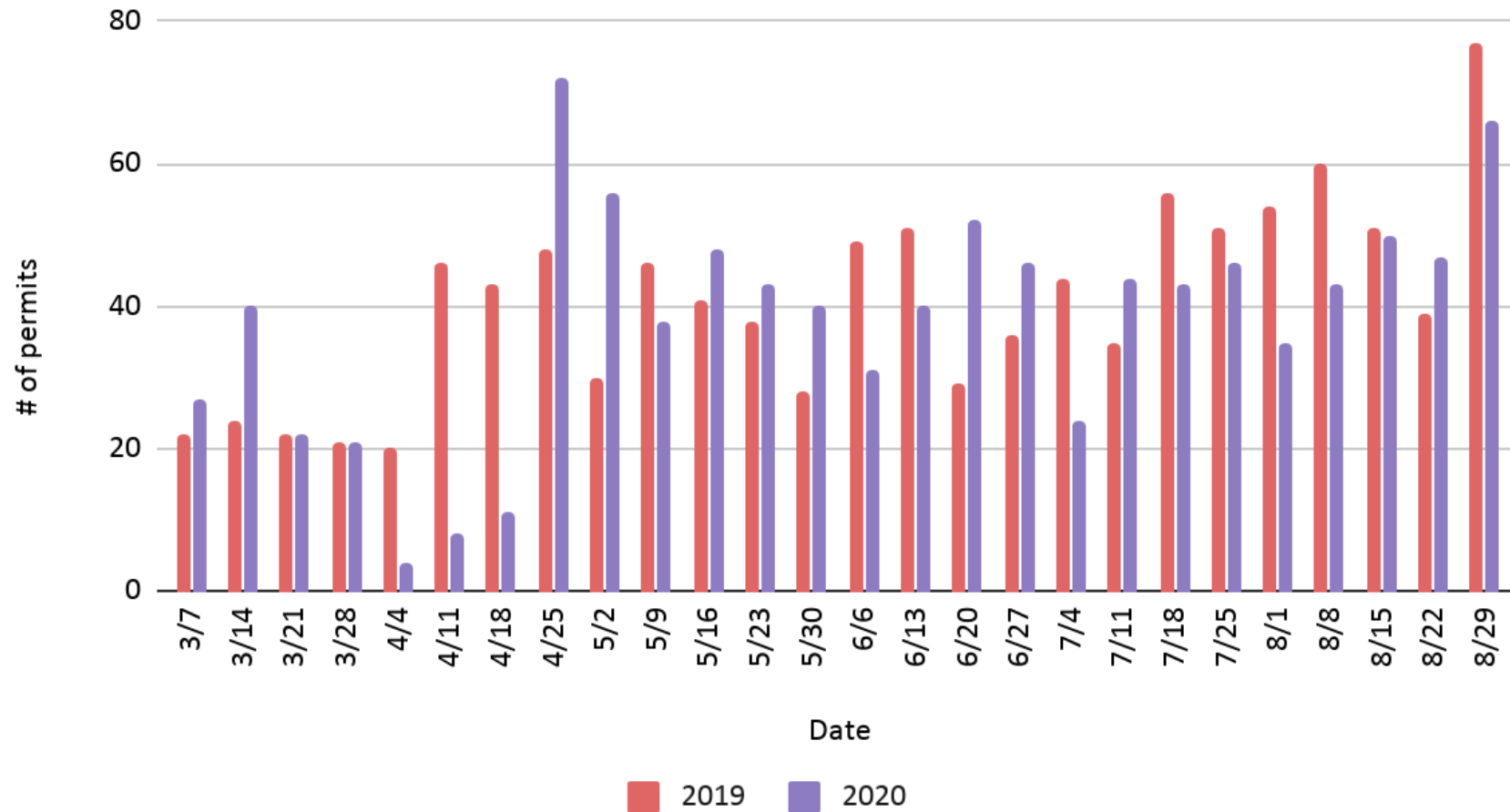

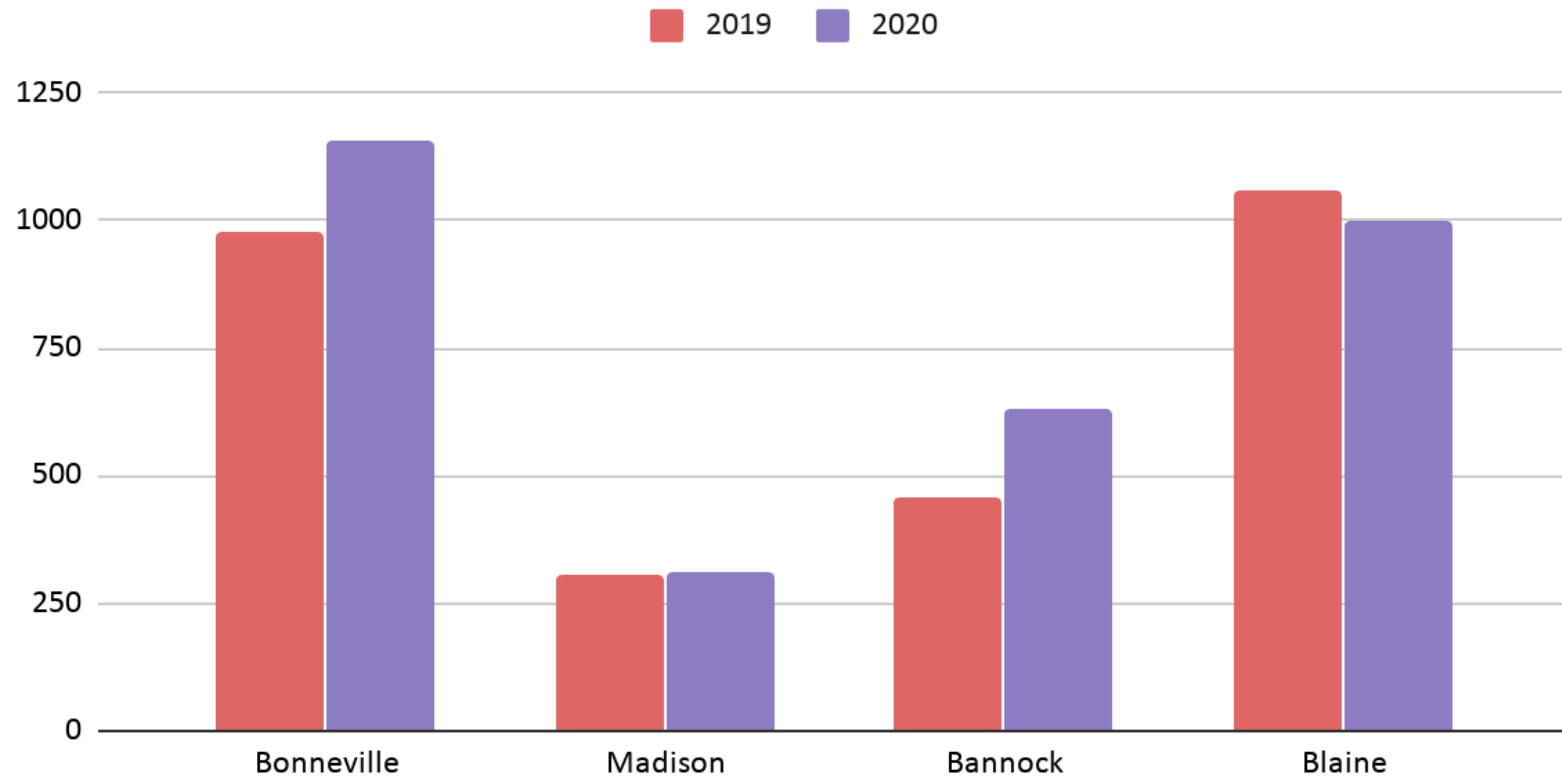

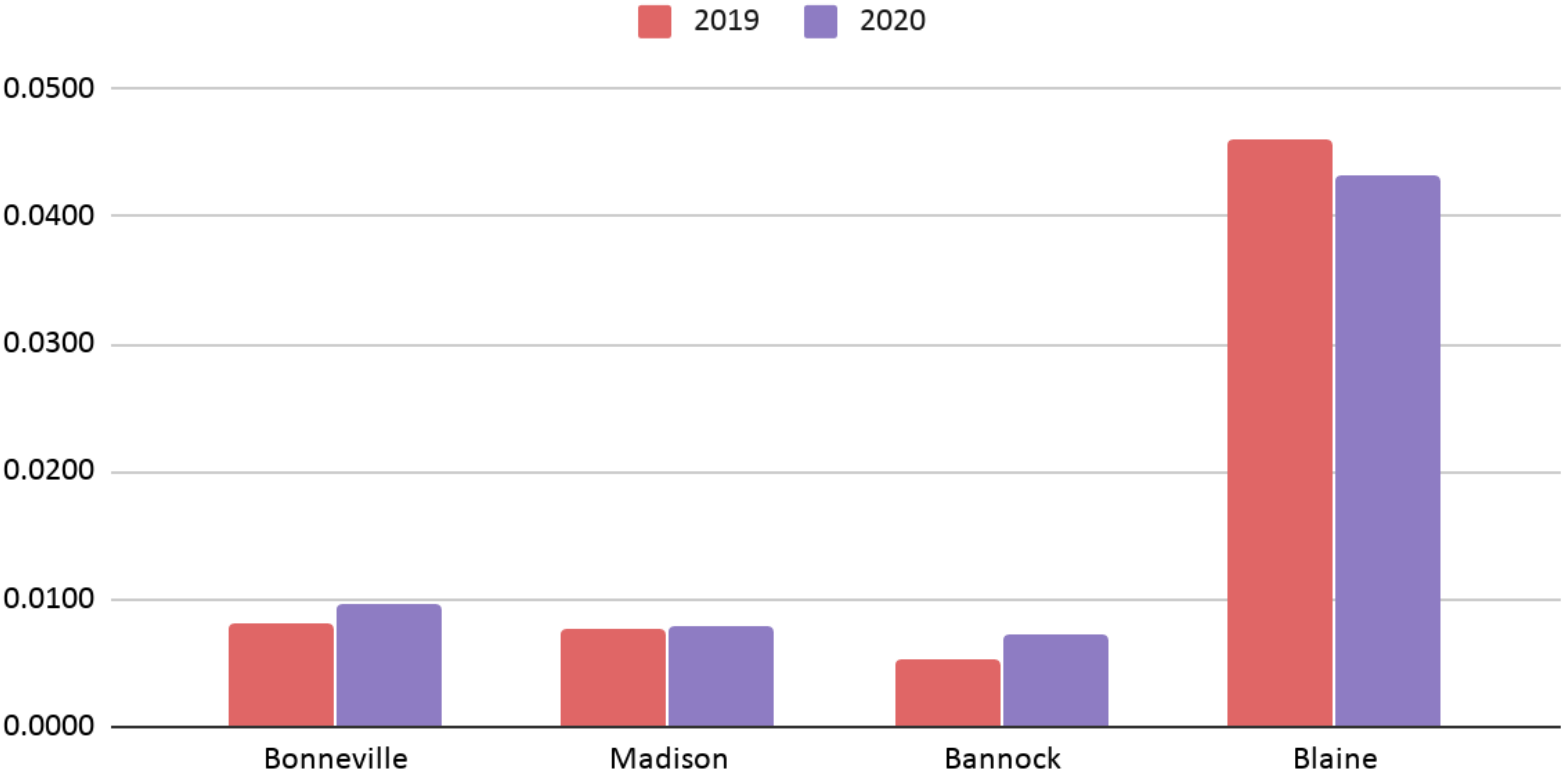

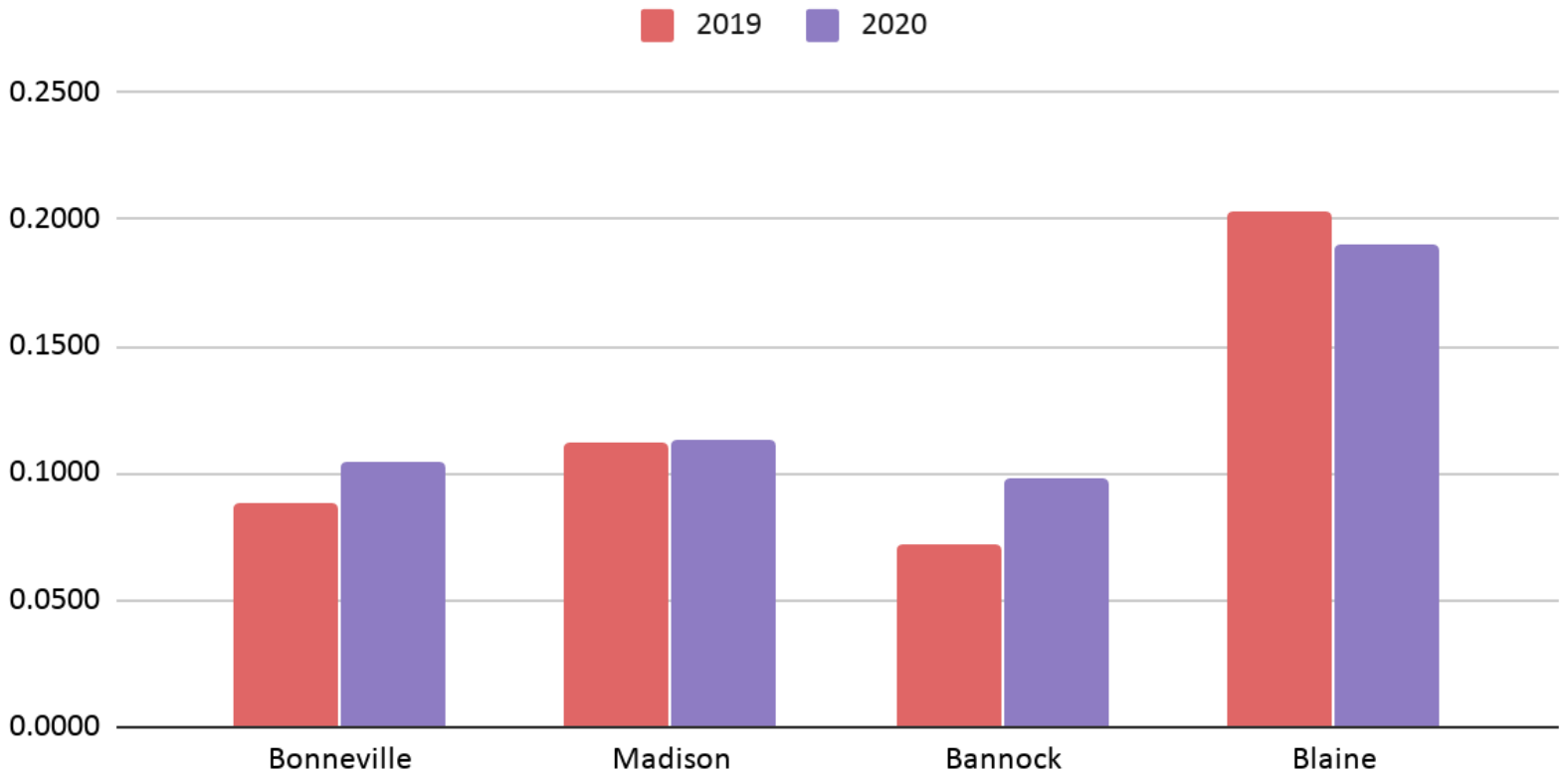

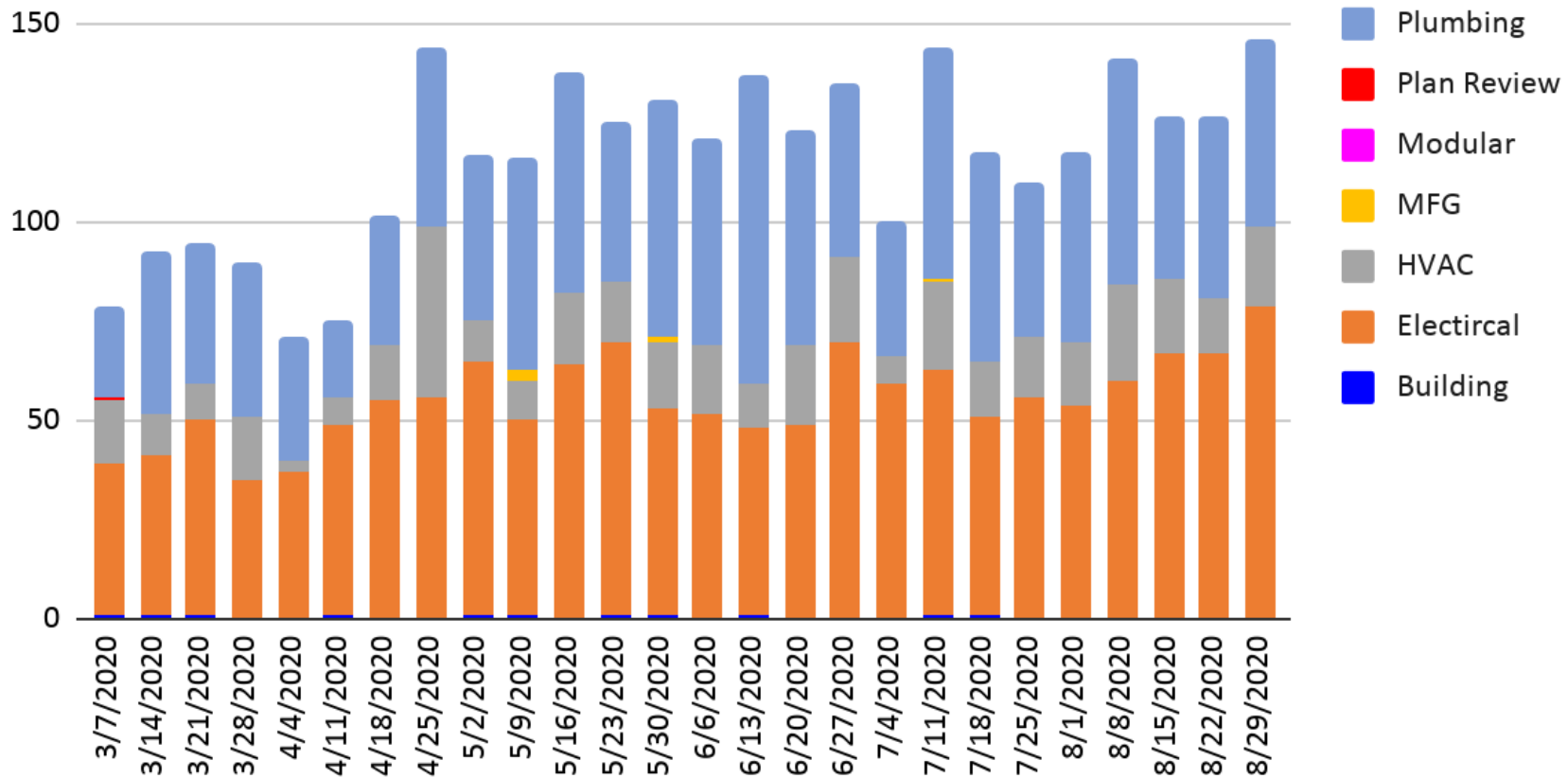

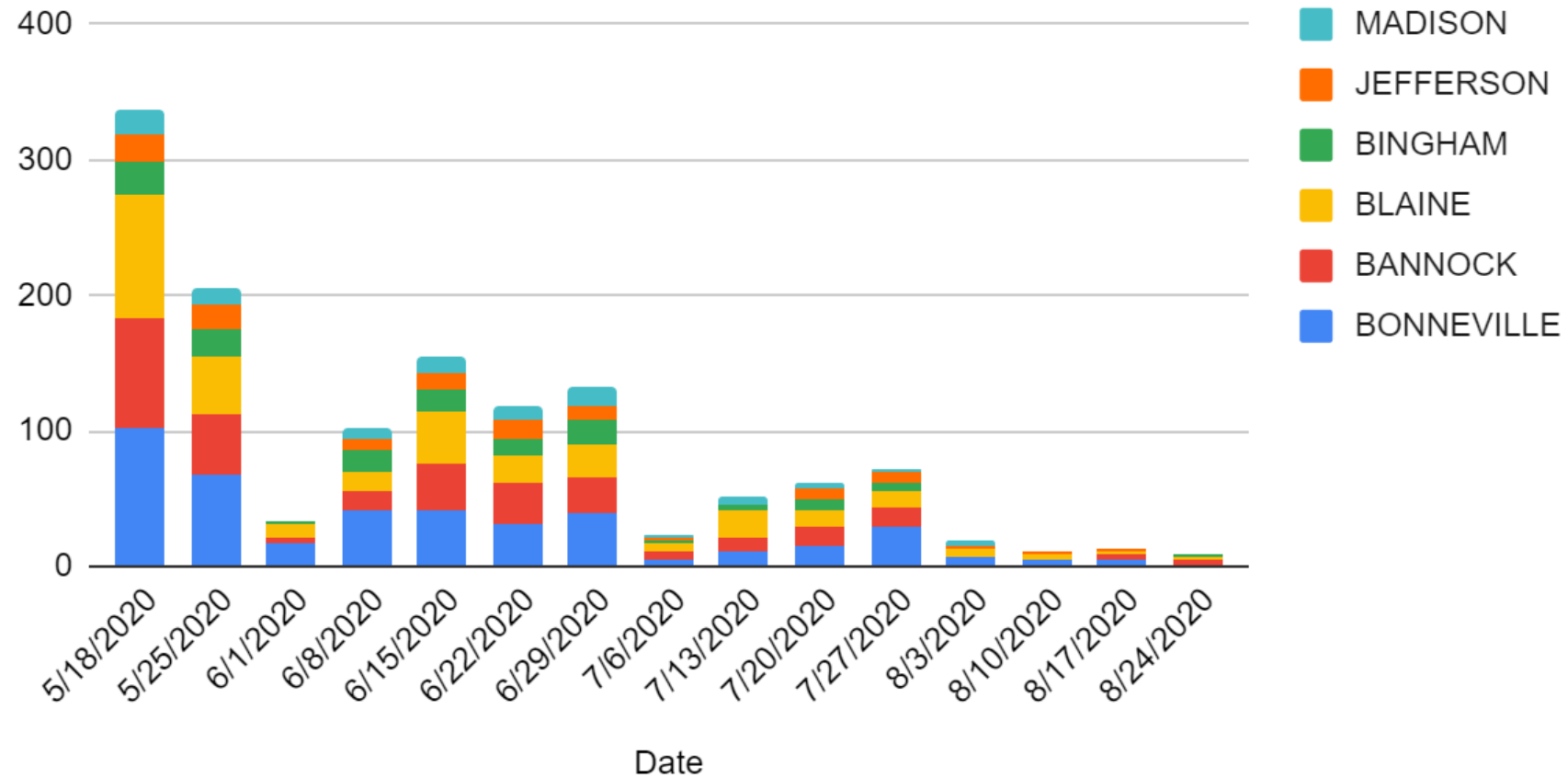

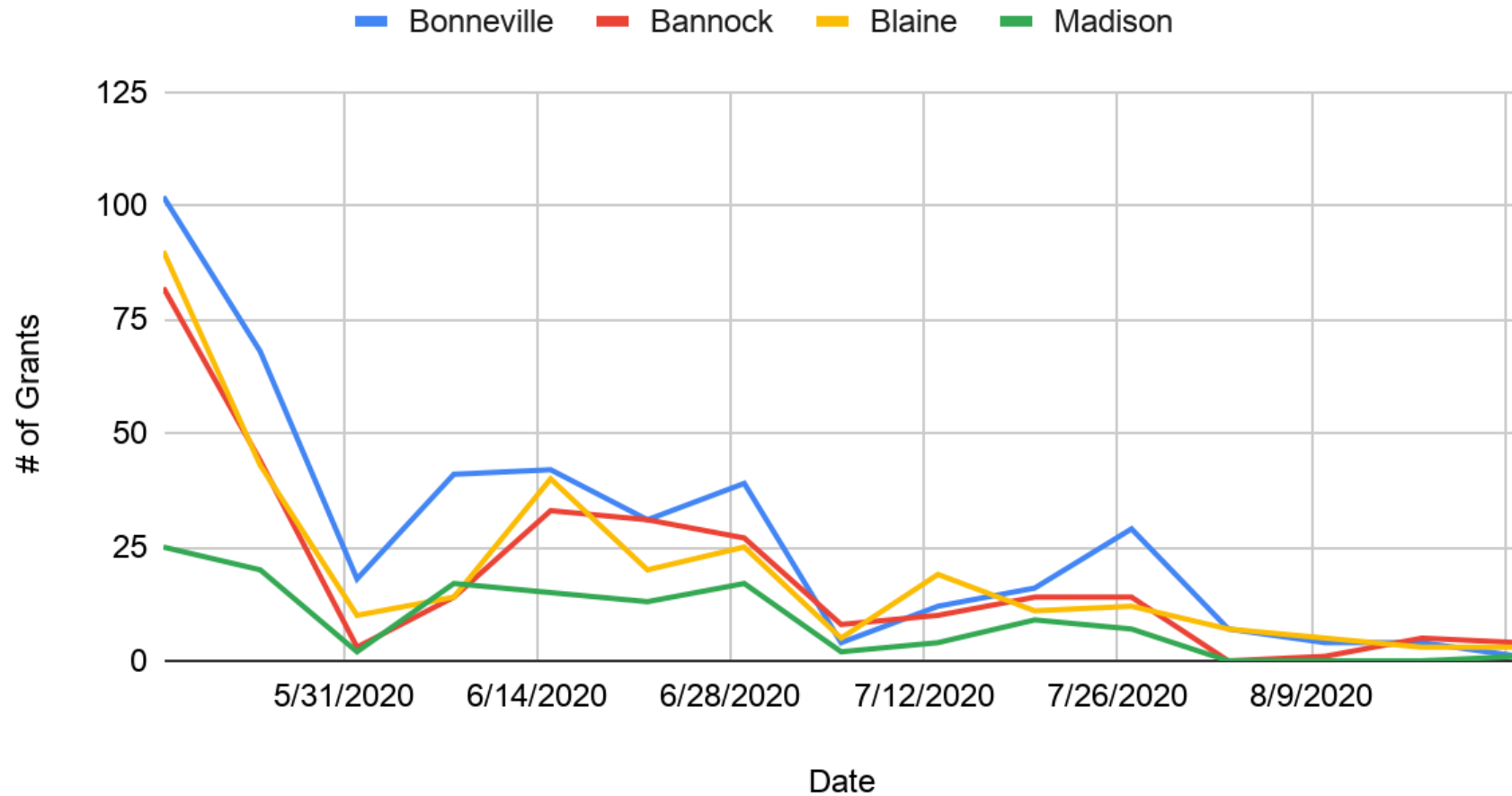

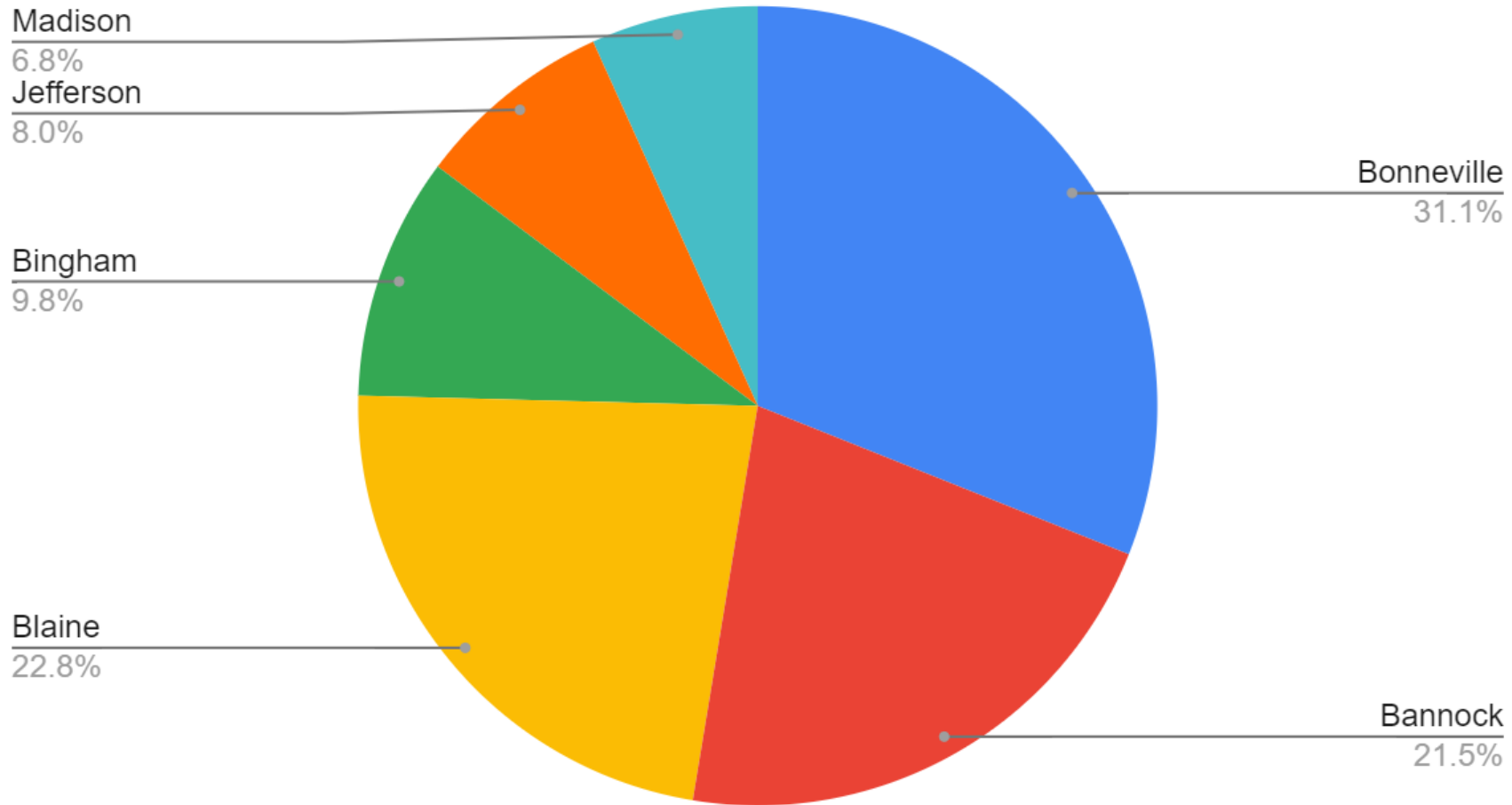

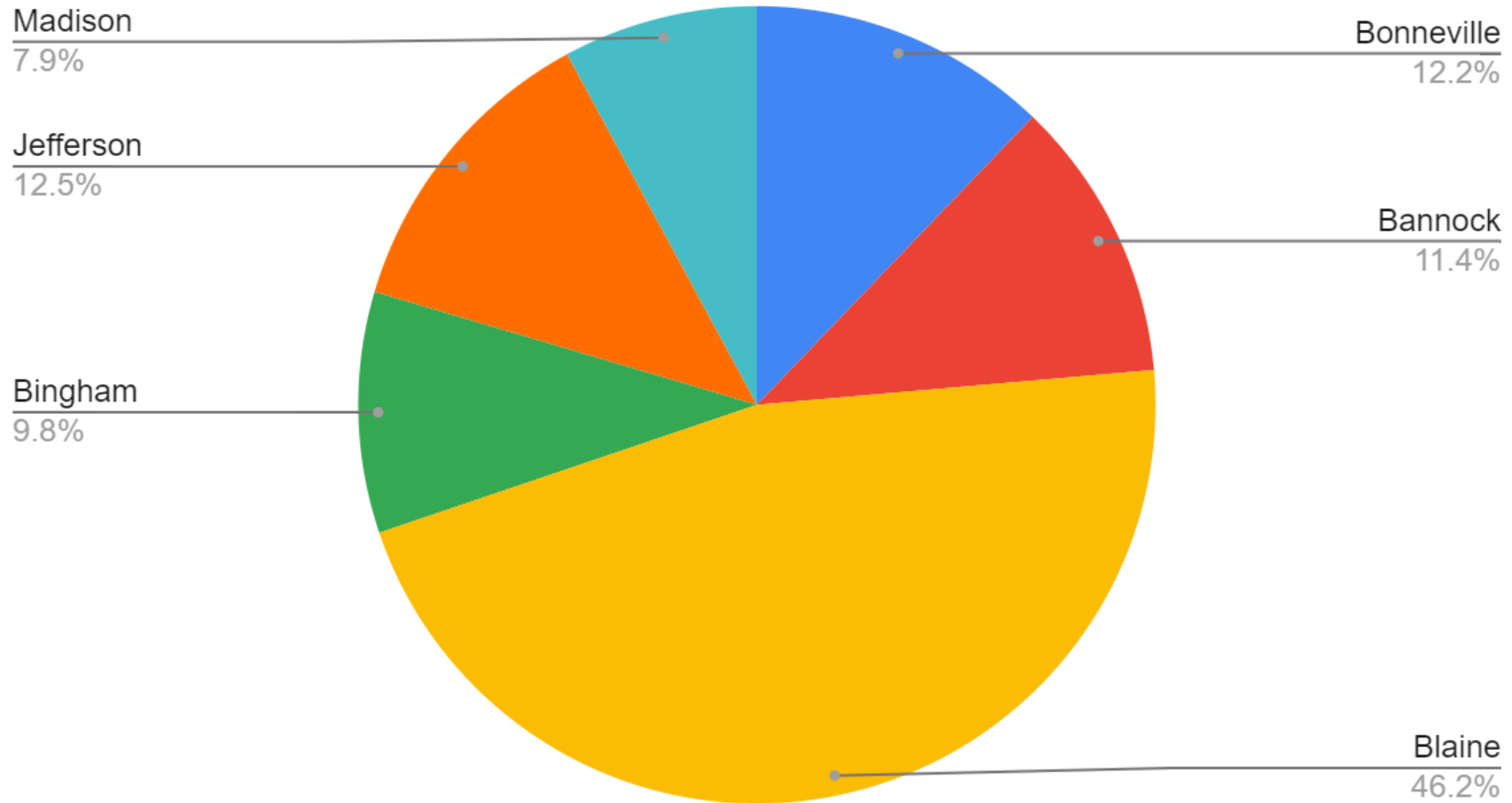
Distribution of Grants by County

Grant Distribution By County



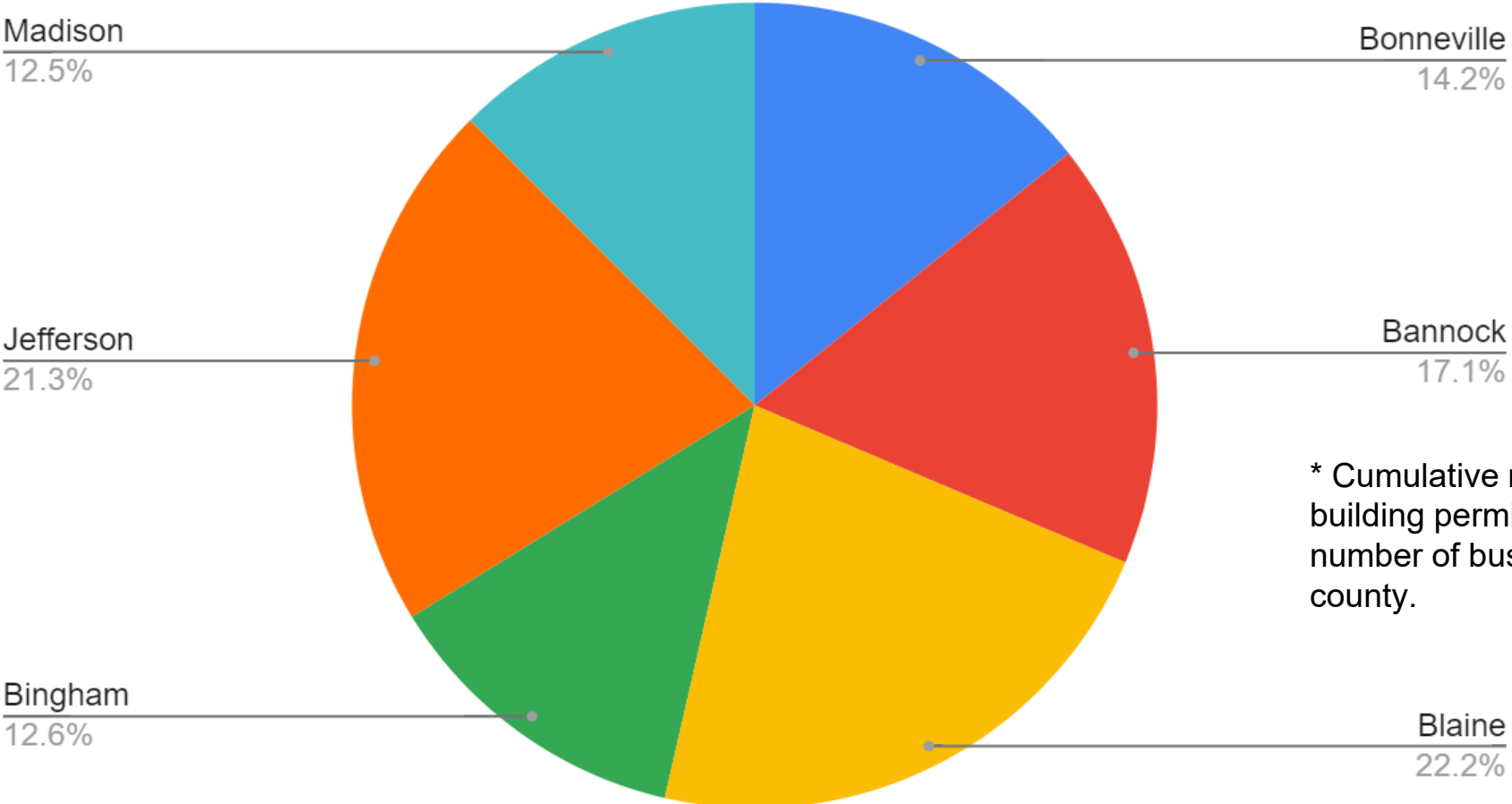
Distribution of Grants Per Capita

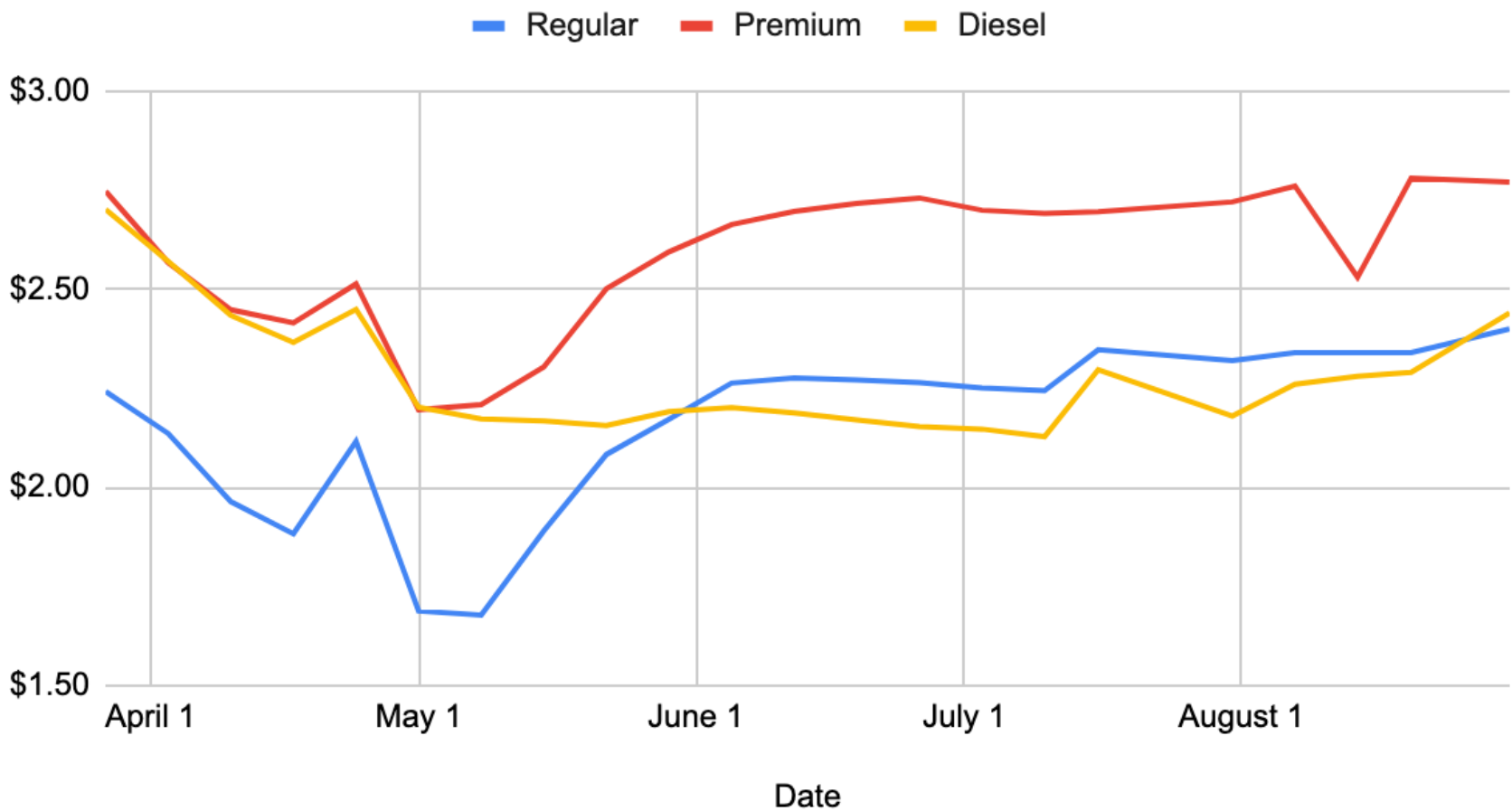

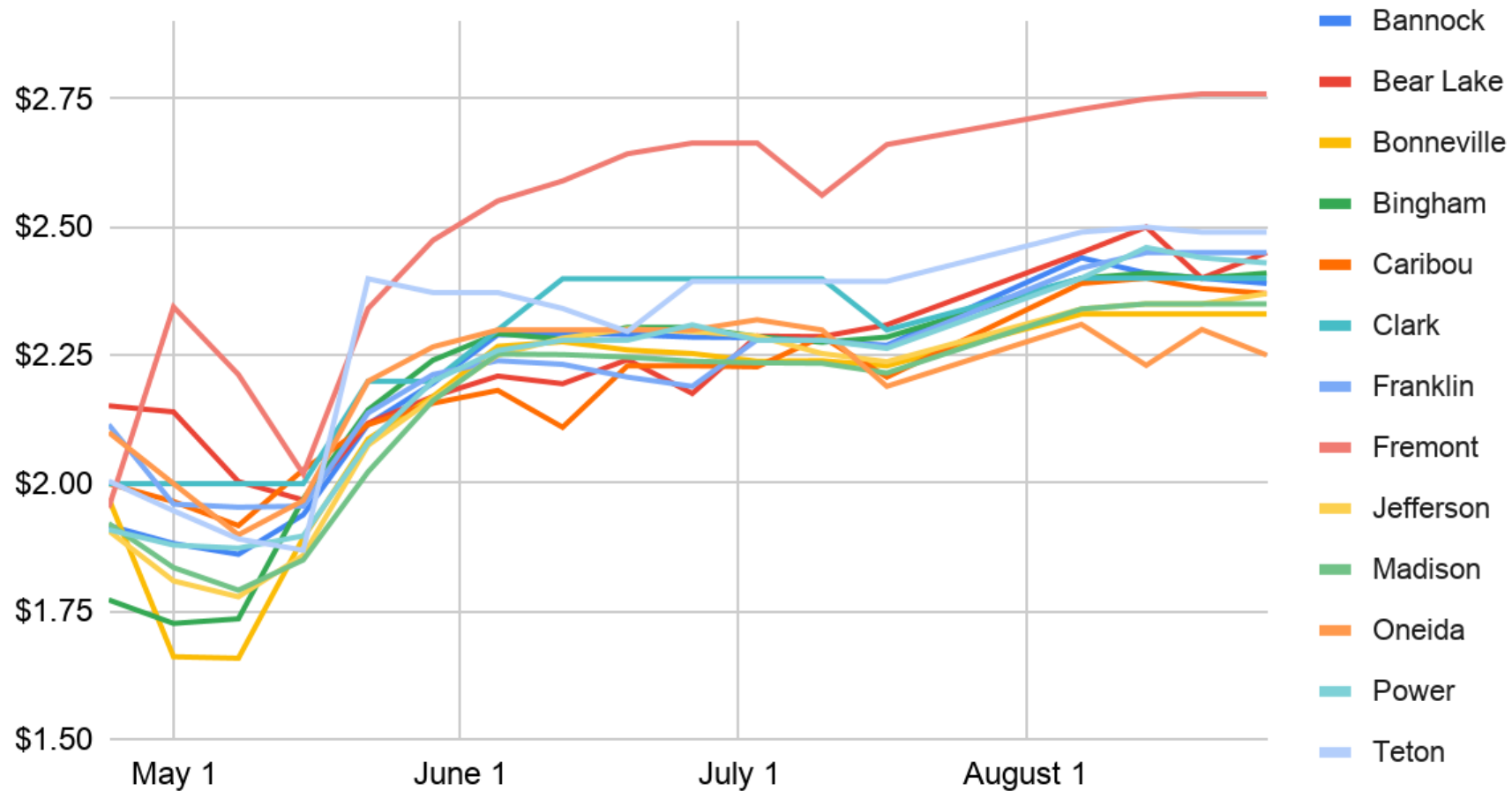
Idaho Falls Weekly Gasoline Prices

Idaho Falls Weekly Gas Prices



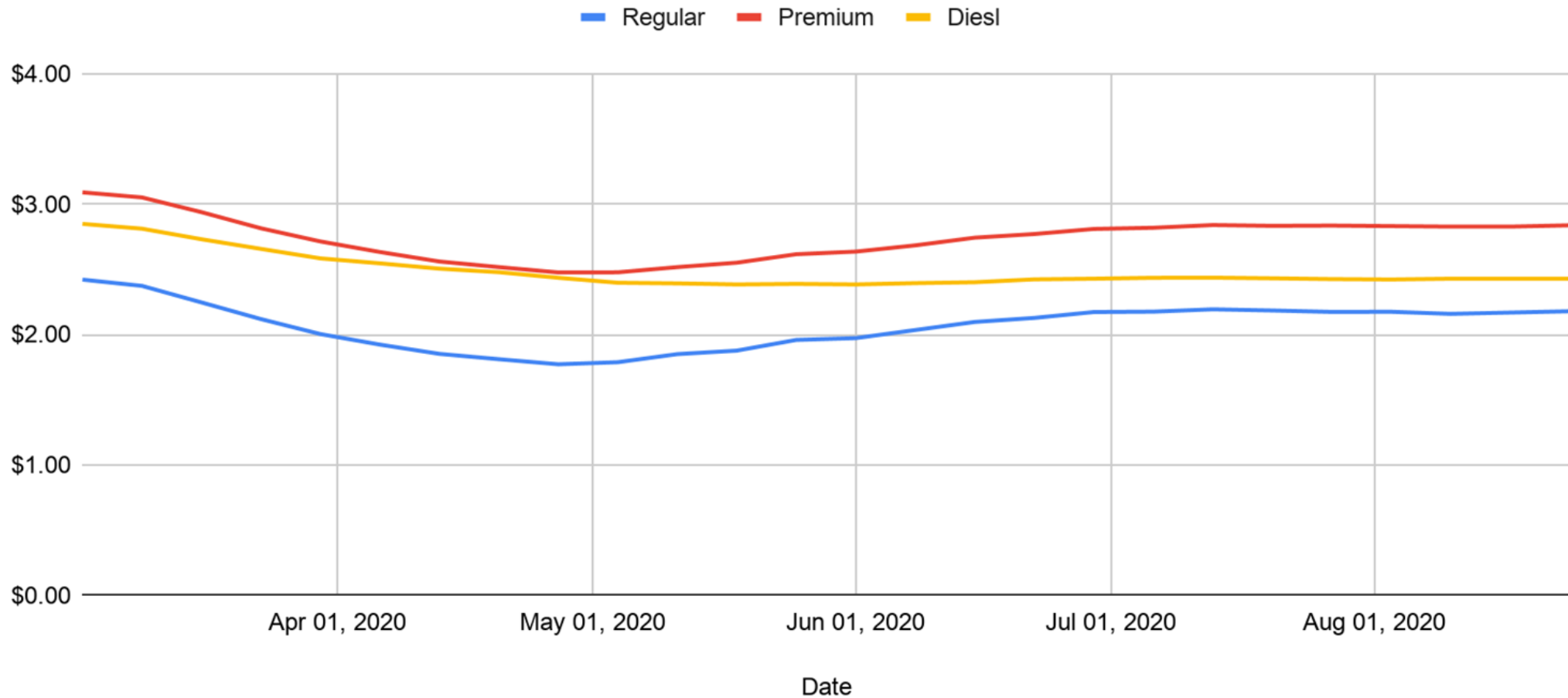
Idaho Counties Gasoline Prices
