- State of Idaho Individual Income Tax dropped for the month of August.




# Weekly Initial Unemployment Claims

# Definitions

An **initial claim** is a claim filed by an unemployed individual after a separation from an employer. The claimant requests a determination of basic eligibility for the UI program. When an initial claim is filed with a state, certain programmatic activities take place and these result in activity counts including the count of initial claims. The count of initial claims for unemployment insurance is a leading economic indicator because it is an indication of emerging labor market conditions in the country. However, these are weekly administrative data which are difficult to seasonally adjust, making the series subject to some volatility.









#### Initial Claims Reported per Week in Ada County




#### Initial Claims Reported since August by County

#### New Claims By Industry




#### What Industries did the claimants work in? (Statewide)














#### **Bonneville Building Permits**









Cumulative Building Permits per Capita







#### Sales Tax



# State of Idaho Individual Income Tax









#### Idaho Counties Gasoline Prices


#### Idaho Counties Gasoline Comparison






#### US Average Daily Rate







#### **US Revenue Per Available Room**






Rexburg High Temp. 2020 vs 2019






Idaho Falls High Temp. 2020 vs. 2019






Pocatello High Temp. 2020 vs 2019




## New This Week








# Are employees more productive at home or the workplace?
