### New This Week

- New Unemployment Claims dropped this week. Continued Unemployment Claims rose slightly this week.
- Building Permit counts rose this week in the reported counties.
- Data from observed deaths in Idaho, Utah, and the United States is included in the report this week.
- Eastern Idaho Hospital ICU Capacity data is included.
- In September and October of this year, Harriman State Park, Lucky Peak State Park, Grand Teton National Park, and Yellowstone National Park all had higher numbers of visitors compared to September and October of 2019.


### **Definitions**


An **initial claim** is a claim filed by an unemployed individual after a separation from an employer. The claimant requests a determination of basic eligibility for the UI program. When an initial claim is filed with a state, certain programmatic activities take place and these result in activity counts including the count of initial claims. The count of initial claims for unemployment insurance is a leading economic indicator because it is an indication of emerging labor market conditions in the country. However, these are weekly administrative data which are difficult to seasonally adjust, making the series subject to some volatility.

### Weekly Unemployment Claims







### Weekly Initial Unemployment Claims









#### Initial Claims Reported during the Last Two Months by County



#### What Industries did the claimants work in? (Statewide)





















Percentage Change from Same Week of Previous Year













## Idaho Observed Deaths and Percent Change from Average for 2020



#### Utah Observed Deaths and Percent Change from Average for 2020



U.S. Observed Deaths and Percent Change from Average for 2020





#### # of COVID Patients in Eastern Idaho ICUs



### Eastern Idaho ICUs


#### Percent Capacity of Eastern Idaho Hospital ICUs





- Boise, Pocatello, Idaho Falls, and Rexburg all experienced a 41-43 degree drop from Nov. 5 - Nov. 9.












#### New This Week

- Many residents of Eastern Idaho counties and Ada county feel that their eating habits have changed this past year. A majority of residents feel that they are eating less healthy foods compared to before the pandemic. Many commented that their stress levels were higher and therefor turning to more comfort type foods.
- Despite the current pandemic, many residents feel that it is safe to fly and are comfortable flying during the holidays. Some comments included thoughts that the airline industry is doing a good job in trying to keep people safe. Some felt it was safer to fly than to shop in a grocery store.
- Many residents are comfortable shopping online as well as in-store for their holiday shopping this year. Some residents commented that they plan on buying from local and/or small businesses, in hopes of helping them financially during this pandemic.




## How Residents Feel Their Eating Habits Have Been During the Pandemic




