

Eastern Idaho COVID-19 Economic Report | March 15, 2021





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
Definition:

An **initial claim** is a claim filed by an unemployed individual after a separation from an employer. The claimant requests a determination of basic eligibility for the UI program. When an initial claim is filed with a state, certain programmatic activities take place and these result in activity counts including the count of initial claims. The count of U.S. initial claims for unemployment insurance is a leading economic indicator because it is an indication of emerging labor market conditions in the country. However, these are weekly administrative data which are difficult to seasonally adjust, making the series subject to some volatility.



Initial Claims (UI Regular) - Statewide


Historical Initial Claims



- After experiencing a surprising spike of initial claims in mid-February, weekly initial claims have begun to drop.
- The original Covid-19 spike occurred in late March of 2020, meaning the state is coming to its 1-year benchmark of its Covid-19 recovery.



Initial Claims (Industry)



- Week 7 was the reported week where Idaho initial claims took a large spike.
- Construction percentage went down meaning other industries increased for week 7.
- Educational services, manufacturing, healthcare services, and technical positions all saw large increases in their percentages of the overall initial claims for the state which could explain the sudden spike in claims for week 7.

Initial Claims (UI Regular) - Ada County


Historical Initial Claims



- Ada County has seen a decent drop in weekly initial claims, dropping by over 300 in the last few weeks.
- Ada county withstood the surprising spike in February and didn't increase their initial claims by the same percentage as most other counties.



Initial Claims (UI Regular) - Bannock County



- Bannock County has an abnormal spike each year during the summer months, as we reach the 1-year benchmark for Covid-19 recovery, Bannock County will be an interesting county to keep an eye on for future reports.
- As of now it appears Bannock County is also on the decline for weekly initial claims.


Week Number

- In previous years, Bonneville County has been one of the most consistently stable counties in the state for weekly initial claims. It's been a rough start to the year though as the numbers have drastically changed week to week.
- Bonneville County could be a key indicator for how the overall economy is doing in Idaho.



Initial Claims (UI Regular) - Madison County .

Historical Initial Claims



- After the spike in February, Madison County has also continued to decline in initial claims.
- Madison County usually declines this time of year in weekly initial claims, it will be interesting to see if that trend continues as the 1-year benchmark for recovery gets closer.
- Madison County will be lifting its mask mandate on March 18th, it will be interesting to see if that changes anything.



Initial Claims (UI Regular) - Twin Falls County

Historical Initial Claims



- Twin Falls County has been the most stable county included with this report as its spikes have been the smallest.
- Twin Falls has stayed relatively close to the trends of previous years with the exception of the spike in February.
- Twin Falls only experienced a relatively small drop of initial claims of the previous week.


"Hot Jobs" are those that on average rank high in three major criteria—abundance of jobs in the economy, jobs that are growing the fastest and jobs with the highest pay.

Changes in Unemployment




- Unemployment rates have gone down from November to December for all counties except Jefferson



Yellowstone National Park Traffic Counts




- February 2021 had less traffic counts than February of 2020 but still had an over 5% increase from February 2019.

of Visitors to Yellowstone National Park




- Almost 214,000 fewer people visited Yellowstone National Park in 2020 from 2019
- This was the lowest number of visitors since 2014
- 2020 ranks as the 6th highest year in terms of the number of visitors to the park all-time
- Despite the decrease in the number of visitors, Yellowstone National Park moved up in the rankings to #2 in the most visited national parks
- Yellowstone National Park has not been ranked #2 since 1947

of Vehicles Visiting Harriman State Park




- The number of vehicles passing through Harriman State Park increased by 32% in 2020 from 2019

[•] February 2021 saw a 12% increase from February 2020




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Mortgage Rate Trends Over Time

• After spiking, Idaho 30-year mortgage rates have dropped below national rates.




While the interest rate has been lowered, the HPI has seen a spike over the past months. However, there is no evidence of a historical relation.




Median Home Price by County (2020)

Mortgage payments increased in each county.


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Ada county has the highest price and the highest increase in price.



Percentage of Households Receiving Food Stamps




- In 2018, 12% received food stamps at some point in the previous 12 months.

Covid-19 Cases on University Campus 2021





% of People Vaccinated by County (Fully Vaccinated)




- 8.02% of the residents of Idaho are fully vaccinated, an increase of 2.25% from last week

 - Utah 7.60%
 - Washington 10.76%
 - Nevada 9.88%
 - Oregon 10.60%
 - Wyoming 12.26%
- Wyoming had the largest absolute week over week increase of the percentage of residents vaccinated at 2.22% while Idaho had an increase of 2.18%




Credit Unions and Banks in Idaho, Total Assets




Credit Unions and Banks in Idaho, Average Assets

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

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


Average deposits spiked in banks, but are declined, while credit unions took longer to start declining.


The large amount of deposits in banks led to an 0.1 decrease in deposits to assets ratio.

National Total Consumer Loans




Banks had a drop in total consumer loans during the second quarter but have been recovering.



National Loan Comparison, Banks.

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
There was a spike in commercial loans, but credit card loans declined during the second quarter.
