








Cost of Gasoline - Jefferson County








Cost of Gasoline - Bonneville County










Cost of Gasoline - Bannock County









Cost of Gasoline - East Idaho vs. State/National Averages









Inflation Impact on Groceries




- Currently Idaho ranks 23rd in States with the highest prices on groceries








Groceries Analysis (Most Purchased Items)








Groceries Analysis (Beverages)




Crime in Eastern Idaho


