


- Population of Idaho has grown by 17.3% since 2010 Census
- It has the second fastest growing rate behind Utah




National Gasoline Price Analysis





Idaho vs. National Gasoline Prices








Minimum Wage Rate for Idaho


 Idaho has had the Federal minimum wage rate of \$7.25 for the past 12 years

 Currently, only 20 states have the Federal minimum wage rate






SNAP Benefits Recipients in Idaho







Average Wheat Price - Bushel






Average Barley Price






