



















 Idaho has had the Federal minimum wage rate of \$7.25 for the past 12 years























## **Number of Bridges - Idaho**








#### **Bridge Improvement - Idaho 2022**




- Idaho received \$225 million this year

#### **Number of Dams by Hazard Classification**







### Idaho's Roads by Lane Miles




- Available funding is insufficient to meet current and future demands
